Our primary purpose is to stay sober and help other alcoholics to achieve sobriety.

Please join me in a moment of silent prayer or meditation followed by the Serenity Prayer.

This is a closed meeting of Alcoholics Anonymous. Attendance at closed meetings is limited to persons who have a desire to stop drinking. If you think you have a problem with alcohol, you are welcome to attend this meeting. In support of A.A.'s singleness of purpose, we ask that when discussing our problems, we confine ourselves to those problems as they relate to alcoholism.

Birthday nights are celebrated the last Friday of each month. Speaker Meeting is the 3rd Saturday of each month. Are there any other AA related announcement? We request all electronic devices be silenced during the meeting.
